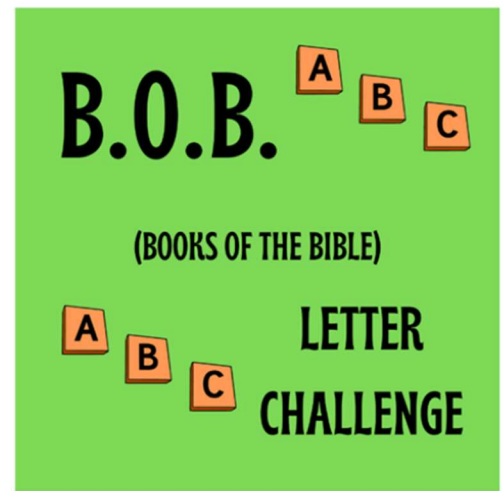


# A GOOD WEEK 3 OR 4 GAME

## HOW TO PLAY

- LAY LETTERS ON TABLE IN A PILE.
- FIRST CHILD DRAWS A CARD FROM THE PILE AND SAYS THE NAME OF A BIBLE BOOK THAT STARTS WITH THAT LETTER. EXAMPLE- - (M=MARK, MATTHEW, MALACHI, & MICAH)
- NEXT CHILD NAMES ANOTHER BOOK STARTING WITH THAT LETTER, IF THEY CAN, THEN PLAY MOVES TO NEXT CHILD.
- IF A CHILD CANNOT NAME ANOTHER BOOK THEN THE PREVIOUS CHILD KEEPS THE CARD
- NEXT CHILD DRAWS ANOTHER CARD AND THE GAME CONTINUES AS BEFORE.
- CHILD WITH THE MOST LETTERS WINS THE GAME, HAVE SMALL TREATS FOR PRIZES.
